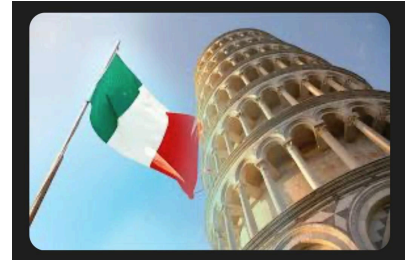


Napa Women's Club
